THE BREVITY BASKET.

Filled With Brief Mention of Many Minor Events of Yesterday.

The receipts from taxes in the district collector's office yesterday were \$2,782.03.

The district chemist is making tests of the various kinds of cement with satisfactory results.

The commissioners have notified Dr. C. E. Purvis, that Pomerooy street, in the country will be improved early in the spring.

Monday afternoon an old colored woman named Sarah Dudo, living at the house of John Brady, back of Germania Schutzen park, was found dead in bed.

A colored girl named Mary F. Wood, 8 years old, living at No. 1632 Fourth street northwest, was burned Monday by her clothes taking fire from a stove, and died soon afterward.

Superintendent of District Fire-alarm Telegraph Mills, with his corps of assistants, were engaged yesterday in connecting the police and fire departments with the new underground cable laid by the Standard Underground Cable company.

In the police court yesterday, George McCaulry, and William, alias Mickey Walsh, were charged with being suspicious characters. Walsh was required to give bonds for his good behavior, and McCaulry was committed to jail for eleven months and twenty-nine days, for assaulting Officer Dunnigan.

Dr. R. G. Dyrenforth, assistant commissioner of patents, has been appointed, under the recommendation of the secretary of the interior, chairman of a board of civil service examiners on special and technical subjects, under clause 5, rule 7, civil service rules. This is the first appointment under this clause.

The accounts of the collectors for the month of November have not yet been audited in consequence of so many non-residents having sent checks from all parts of the country and Europe to pay taxes. The citizens had to be accommodated first and the checks accumulated to such an extent that the accounts have not yet been made up.
