Dr. L. Tyler testified: "I found a number of wounds on the face, some of them superficial, others extending to the bone, with fracture of the two malar bones and of the upper jawbone; also fracture of the left nose, just in front of the angle, and also fracture of the bridge of the nose; no fracture of the skull. There were no wounds on the head other than those superficial ones about the face. These wounds might have been by a man's boot, but not with the flat at one blow. Death would have resulted from any one of these wounds if the man had not been killed."

New York, Nov. 4.—The stock market was moderately active and strong from opening to close, though the advance was slow and steady. The lowest prices were made in the first hour, and the best in the last hour, most stocks closing at the highest price of the day. There was little news, except the advance on rates agreed upon in the northwest, which had a stimulating effect upon the grain and to some degree upon the remainder. The sentiment was moderately bullish, with the foreign exchange little or nothing and commission people buying for small amounts. The traders were ranged on the side of lower prices and were with a few exceptions, bearish, bringing about a reaction.
