





No. 226-Appearing Dime in Handker

A handkerchief is spread out and shaken to show that it contains noth-ing. It is then crumbled up into a ball and given to a spectator to hold. When he opens up the handkerchief he finds a dime has appeared within its folds.

To perform this trick use a handker chief with a very wide hem. A bit of the hem is loosened near one corner and a dime is slipped through the open-ing. The handkerchief may now be shown empty, and shaken, provided the opened corner is kept downward. In folding the handkerchief all four corners are bunched together and it is shaken slightly. SIX STATE RAILROADS HAVING INJUNCTIONS TO APPEAR IN COURT

(By Associated Press)

INDIANAPOLIS, July 24.-Six railroads operating in Indiana having obtained temporary injunctions to restrain striking employes from interfering with the movement of mail, interstate freight and passengers, will appear before Judge Francis E. Baker in federal court here tomorrow to ask that permanent injunctions be grant-

The roads having temporary injunctions are the Big Four, Wabash, Baltimore and Ohio, Cincinnati, Indianapolis and Western, Monon and Chicago and Erie.

The injunction petitions filed by the railroads are almost identical and all name the following organizations of the strikers: International Association of Machinists, International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, International Brotherhood of Blacksmith Drop Forgers and Helpers, Iron Shipbuilders and Helpers of America, the International Alliance of Sheet Metal Workers, the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers and the Brotherhood of Railway Carmen.

Judge Baker granted the temporary injunctions following hearings at Hammond. He is acting as judge in the Indiana district during the vacation of Judge A. B. Anderson. Judge Baker is on the bench of the U. S. circuit court of appeals at Chicago.
