

NEW EXPRESS RULES IN FORCE

The new express packing rules made by the better service committee of the American Railway Express Co. are now in effect. Under the new regulations all express shipments of more than twenty-five pounds must be forwarded in wooden containers or cartons bearing the boxmaker's certificate as to strength and size required by the express company. Shipments under twenty-five pounds will be accepted as heretofore.

Christmas shippers are advised not only to send their packages early, but to see that they were properly packed and accurately addressed. Agents will be glad to give full information in regard to shipment of packages.

RELATIVES WILL ASSUME DEBTS

CHICAGO, Dec. 12.—Relatives of Charles Clump Adst, Chicago and New York broker, suspended from membership in the Chicago stock exchange for failure to meet his obligations, are today planning to take over this indebtedness, which is estimated at close to \$500,000.

The half million dollar indebtedness involves 175 trading accounts which Adst was unable to meet. The largest of these was a credit account of \$128,000 due the estate of the late John McCabe, Chicago capitalist.

Auditors representing heirs of this estate uncovered the unpaid accounts and reported them to the board of directors of the Chicago stock exchange. Adst's suspension here yesterday followed.

ZBYSZKO GETS HIS PASSPORTS

Through the efforts of James Hamilton Lewis, former United States senator from Illinois, Stanislaus Zbyszko, champion of the world's heavyweight wrestling championship, has obtained passports to visit America.

Col. Lewis became interested in Zbyszko's tour because of the Polish giant's desire to raise money for the Polish relief fund. He will appear in several matches in the interest of this fund, donating his entire share to the cause. Zbyszko, it was announced last night, probably will arrive in New York Jan. 25th.
