

### RAY ABBOTT BEATEN FOR RE-ELECTION

Hammond Men Chosen Vice President and Secretary of State Building Trades.

EVANSVILLE, IND., Aug. 26.—At the closing session of the ninth annual convention of the Indiana State Building Trades Council here, Charles Kern, of Indianapolis, who has been first vice-president of the organization for the last year, was elected president. He defeated Ray F. Abbott, of Gary, who was up for re-election. The vote was 46 to 42.

Other officers were elected as follows: First vice-president, John Meers, Hammond; second vice-president, C. M. Feltz, Ft. Wayne, third vice-president, Edward Wilke, Evansville, fourth vice-president, W. T. Hayworth, Muncie; fifth vice-president, H. F. Cadwallader, Lafayette. Henry Gable, of Hammond, was re-elected secretary-treasurer. A. Bartholomew, of Gary, and E. H. Large, of Indianapolis, were elected delegates to the convention of the Indiana Federation of Labor, which was convened here Wednesday.

It was found near the close of the session that Harold Brung, a boy of fifteen years of Terra Haute, had served as a delegate in the convention throughout the sessions, and the constitution of the state council provides that no one who has not reached the age of twenty-one can be a delegate. This was said to have been the first instance of its kind in the history of the state organization.

The convention passed a resolution to wage a strenuous fight on the "American plan" or open shop.

### GOAL MINERS GET WAGE INCREASE

INTERNATIONAL NEWS SERVICE CHICAGO, Aug. 26.—Day men in Illinois coal mines will be granted an increase in wages of \$1.50 per day, making a scale of \$7.50 for eight hours' work and it is believed today that the coal wage controversy in Illinois has been ended.

The agreement of the \$1.50 increase will be reported today to the full scale.

### NEGROES ESCAPE TO CHICAGO

The two armed and bold negroes who struck up L. P. Swoverland, Pennsylvania ticket agent at Gary early Tuesday morning and made their escape with some \$300 in cash, some tickets and the agent's watch and money have so far eluded the authorities and likely have made their escape into Chicago.

The daring negro bandits staged their hold-up shortly after Ticket Agent Swoverland opened the ticket office window while waiting for the Atlantic express to pull in about one o'clock. The station was deserted at the time.

Both wore overalls. One of them shoved a revolver through the grating of the ticket office window and demanded that Swoverland open the grating and hold up his hands. They were of a desperate type and offered no resistance.

As soon as the ticket agent had raised the window one of them crawled through the opening and entered the ticket office while the second bandit stood guard over the waiting room and the ticket office.

Things were turned upside down and the place was ransacked. After the negro had gone through the cash drawer and safe, he took about \$50 in cash and a watch from the ticket agent.

A long freight train delayed the arrival of the police. It is also reported that the two bandits cut the telephone wires and for this reason Swoverland was forced to run to a restaurant to call the police.

The two bandits were seen later in the vicinity of 8th avenue and Maryland street where they bought a bottle of milk from a milk man.


