Ten Thousand Persons Live in One Block in New York

(INTERNATIONAL NEWS SERVICE) NEW YORK, Oct. 11.—The housing situation in New York City as it exists at present is both immoral and a menace to the people, according to

Health Commissioner Royal S. Copeland.

"The housing conditions in this city are unbelievable," said Commissioner Copeland. "There are many apartments of three rooms in which twelve persons are living. On West One Hundred and Forty-second street there is a building where the landlord formerly got \$55 a month for each floor. He divided each floor into two apartments and now gets \$150 a month for the space for which he formerly received \$55.

"This landlord has boarded up the dumbwaiters for kitchenettes in the rear apartments, and for kitchenettes in the front apartments he has used the toilets. Such conditions as this will result in cholera if they are not checked.

"In one square block in the City of New York there are 10,000 persons living. In one square mile there are 500,000 persons living. Such condition is a menace to public health and to morals."




