RETAIL FOOD PRICES REDUCED

WASHINGTON, Dec. 18.—Retail food prices decreased during November, the bureau of labor statistics announced this afternoon.

The cost of 22 articles making up the retail food index carried by the bureau, decreased 2 1/2 per cent as compared with the cost during October, it was announced.

The report shows, however, that between November, 1919, and November, 1921, the increased cost of 22 food articles was 1 per cent.

INDIANA LOSES 98 INSTRUCTORS

INDIANAPOLIS, Ind., Dec. 18.—Indiana's higher educational institutions are termed a "stagnant ground" for institutions in other states, "who pay more than we do" for instructors, declares the annual report on universities, submitted to Gov. Goodrich and the general assembly today by Wm. Lewis Bryan, president of the university.

Ninety-eight instructors have gone to 26 other institutions "from Harvard to the University of California," and other colleges, "will get all the best men unless we can have substantial relief," the report asserts.
