

NEED OF ORDINANCE IS SHOWN

Failure of the East Chicago Common Council to pass the ordinance prohibiting the sale and display of firearms, was followed last evening by a window in a store being broken and two revolvers, one automatic and one police Colt being stolen.

The store which is conducted by A. Arnoff has for some time been exhibiting in its windows all sorts of different death dealing weapons, and any person who has the price can without any permit whatsoever purchase a revolver or any other instrument of this nature.

Mayor McCormack, along with Police Chief Ed. O'Donnell, have used all their power and influence to have the council pass this ordinance, but there appears to be some friction on the part of the chairman of the council, in holding up the ordinance, who has an idea that limiting the sale and display of the firearms might cause the business to be thrown over to a few peo-

ple. This however, is entirely wrong, the purpose of the ordinance only prohibits the sale of the firearms without a permit. This ordinance of course would mean that a person would have to have unquestionable character before the department of public safety, would issue a permit.

Then again it would mean that the criminal class would be unable to purchase revolvers as is now the case, which would eliminate a large number of murders and robberies which have prevailed in the past.

It is a known fact that a lot of revolvers, blackjacks, stilettes and other weapons on exhibition in any window have a certain tendency in attracting those criminally inclined. This attraction once entering into a crook's mind, no matter of mere price could prevent the criminal from purchasing. The gun or weapon becomes his pet, and when a criminal has a pet, no matter what it may be, nothing in the world can prevent him from getting that pet, where a matter of dollars and cents are concerned.

The ordinance as drawn by City Attorney Crites stipulates that any one exhibiting a revolver, blackjack or any other weapon of this kind, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50. It further says that any merchant who sells a revolver or any other

death dealing weapon without a permit from the Department of Public Safety, will also be subject to a fine of not less than \$50.

The ordinance has now gone to third reading, and will come up before the next meeting of the council the first Monday in January.


