HAWKEYES CLOSE WITH A VICTORY

HAD EASY TIME DEFEATING WASHINGTON U. OF ST. LOUIS BY A 38 TO 0 SCORE.

St. Louis, Mo., Nov. 21.—The Iowa State university football team won from the Washington university here Saturday by 38 to 0. The game was featured by the brilliant work of Quarterback Curry and Captain Hyland of the Iowa squad.

Ray Murphy, left halfback of the Iowa eleven, was elected captain of the 1911 team following the game.

The Iowans outwitted their opponents and had no trouble at any period in crushing the local defense. The first points were made in five minutes after the teams clashed, when Hyland went over for a touchdown.

Curry returned to the game and made gains by his runs. He placed the ball on the 25-yard line, and after forward passes followed Murphy's punt, Curry went off tackle and gained the distance for a touchdown. Hyland again kicked goal.

This play was repeated by Curry. Banton and Hyland for another touchdown and goal. The game ended with the ball in Iowa's possession in mid-field.
