

MUSCATINE BAPTIST CHURCH 72 YRS. OLD

Muscataine, Oct. 23.—The seventy-second anniversary of the founding of the First Baptist church in this city will be observed on Thursday evening, Oct. 30, by a very fitting program. The local church was founded on October 30, 1841, and has developed into one of Muscatine's most potent spiritual forces.

The program on that evening will consist of a variety of discussions and several splendid musical offerings. It was announced by the Rev. ASKS AID OF JAPS AGAINST THE U. S. A.

MAN WANTED IN BOSTON FOR ABDUCTION DOES NOT WANT TO BE RETURNED.

Tokio, Oct. 23.—John Ellis business manager of the Japan Advertiser, arrested here October 13 on a requisition from the American ambassador for alleged perjury, today issued an appeal from prison asking Japan not to deliver him to the United States, and stating that he desired to become a Japanese citizen. Ellis is wanted in Boston for the alleged abduction of his daughter and for contempt of court. He said in his appeal that he is a victim of a conspiracy to obtain possession of his daughter who was awarded by the Boston courts to his wife after their separation. He has never committed perjury, he vowed.

The United States government opposed the admission of Ellis to bail.

John Ellis was formerly a clergyman, a telegraph operator and a broker. After separation from his wife he took an office as broker in a back bay hotel at Boston. About a year ago his wife's daughter went for a walk and disappeared. Mrs. Ellis traced the couple to Japan through moving pictures.

Abduction is not an extraditable offense and for this reason the American ambassador asked for the arrest of Ellis on a perjury charge.

WOMEN UNITE TO FIGHT LIVING COST

THE PHILADELPHIA HOUSEWIVES PLAN TO CUT MIDDLE-MAN'S PROFITS.

Philadelphia, Pa., Oct. 23.—Philadelphia housewives and retail butchers organized yesterday to fight the high cost of living by cutting out the middleman's profits. Leaders in the movement promise that the price of meat, butter and eggs will be reduced 10 to 20 per cent below current rates. The housewives under the leadership of Mrs. Wm. B. Derr, who conducted the egg crusade here last winter, agreed to give their patronage to the butchers who are forming to buy beef directly from the producers.

Efforts are being made to enroll six thousand butchers in the organization which proposes to buy beef directly from Argentina and eggs and butter from western dairies and creameries.

AUTOMOBILES HELP THE RURAL CHURCH

Iowa City, Oct. 23.—Automobiles help the rural church.

This was the conclusion of Rev. H. P. Chaffee of the Baptist church of this city after an investigation which he made in his study for a doctor's degree from the University of Iowa.

The Rev. Mr. Chaffee bases his statement upon facts which he has collected. Part of the material for the study was obtained from a questionnaire conducted in Johnson county by William N. Hunt who prepared a thesis on the rural church.

Forty-three of the 49 churches in Johnson county are outside of Iowa City, and from the 43 churches it was found that thirty-two ministers answered that the automobile did not hinder the church attendance.

Only eight stated unqualifiedly that the automobile hindered the churches. Three were doubtful—stating that the automobiles probably did not hinder the church attendance although they were not sure.

In these rural churches the answers indicated that the ministers estimated 10 per cent of their parishioners owned automobiles so that the effect either way was not great.

The Rev. Mr. Chaffee probably will extend his rural survey of the automobile and the church to other counties before the end of the year.

This investigation is being conducted under the direction of the faculty of the University of Iowa.

APPANOOSE COURT OPENS OCT. 27

Centerville, Oct. 23.—Only a few more cases were filed in the clerk's office the last day of filing to get on the docket for the term of court opening Oct. 27.

WANTS \$5,000 DAMAGES FOR HER PICTURE

Cedar Rapids, Oct. 23.—A pamphlet showing frequent use of a beautiful young woman with a pretty set of teeth on one page and on the reverse the same young woman with poor molars has been paraded daily before the eyes of twelve men, the jurors hearing the evidence in the district court of Miss Bessie Hoffman, a stenographer of Waterloo, against Dr. W. R. Harmon, a local dentist.

Miss Hoffman, a pretty young woman of twenty, with a wealth of wavy hair and a set of pearly teeth, is seeking to recover \$5,000 damages from Dr. Harmon as a result of the publication of her picture in his advertising pamphlet. It is said that 90,000 of these pamphlets were sent out.

Miss Hoffman and Mrs. McDonald, daughter of Dr. Harmon, were girl friends and the two families were brought together by their father. The Harmon and McDonalds visited back and forth. One night, so it is alleged, Miss Hoffman was at the home of Dr. Harmon, when he asked for her picture, saying that he would like to have it showing her beautiful set of teeth. The defense claims she consented to give him the photograph, knowing what use would be made of it. The plaintiff admits giving her consent, but denies she had any knowledge that it was to be used as it was in the pamphlet. It is claimed that Dr. Harmon had two pictures made for his pamphlet.

COLT STREET PARADE IN MT. PLEASANT

Mt. Pleasant, Oct. 22.—The second day of the Henry county corn and colt show broke all records both as to attendance and to the number of colts registered. At 9 o'clock, the hour for the closing of registration, there were one hundred and two colts registered. This exceeds by twenty-three the registration of last year, when Henry county stood second in the state. Despite the cold weather and the bad conditions of the roads the attendance was unusually large.

The Roos feed yard, where the show was held was packed all day with exhibitors and visitors. The entire forenoon was occupied in the judging of the animals. The Judge, Mr. Kennedy of Ames, stated that he had never seen better stock than that shown to-day, and that the Henry county show was far ahead, both in numbers and quality of the stock exhibited, of any county show that had ever been held in the state of Iowa. In the afternoon, led by the Cadet band the colts were lined up and marched around the square. The streets were crowded with spectators.

Helsingfors, Finland, Oct. 23.—Forty sailors and passengers on board the Finnish steamer West Kusten were drowned today when the vessel struck a reef near Vaasa in the gulf of Bothnia and went down. None were rescued.

TRYING TO SHOW THAW IS INSANE

LAWYERS IN NEW YORK TRYING TO PREVENT INDICTMENT ON CONSPIRACY CHARGE.

New York, Oct. 23.—A blanket indictment charging Harry K. Thaw and four others with conspiracy in connection with his escape from the Matteawan hospital for the criminal insane in August last, was returned by the grand jury here this afternoon. It will be used as a weapon by William Travers Jerome in his efforts to extradite Thaw from New Hampshire.

New York, Oct. 23.—Twenty witnesses were under subpoena to testify before the supreme court grand jury which met today for an investigation of the charges of conspiracy in connection with the escape of Harry K. Thaw from the Matteawan hospital for criminal insane at Matteawan on August 17. Former District Attorney William T. Jerome was designated by Attorney General Carmody to present the evidence.

The witnesses summoned were residents of Matteawan and New York through whom Mr. Jerome hoped to show a conspiracy existed.

Counsel for Thaw, on the other hand were prepared to make strenuous efforts to prevent an indictment on the ground that he is insane and therefore cannot be called to trial. This stand will be taken on the basis of Justice Seabury's recent ruling that Thaw was an "insane person" when called as a witness in the recent investigation of charges against John N. Anhalt.

John Collins, proprietor of an Eighth avenue garage, was one of the first witnesses to appear. Collins, it was said, was asked about the renting of the black machine in which Thaw made his dash for liberty.

The Duchesne county grand jury, in which Matteawan is situated, failed to return an indictment against Thaw for conspiracy and an indictment is sought as a weapon in the fight to extradite him from New Hampshire.

SULZER FAILS TO PAY HIS LAWYERS

COUNSEL FOR DEPOSED GOVERNOR OR LOOKING TO STATE FOR PROFESSIONAL FEES.

Albany, N. Y., Oct. 23.—Unless a special bill is introduced in the legislature for the payment of the fees of William Sulzer's counsel, they probably will not receive a cent for their work. Nor will they take the initiative in having such a bill introduced, Judge D. Cady Herrick said today.

"We shall not ask the state to pay us," he said, "nor do we expect any pay from Mr. Sulzer. He has not paid us anything and we shall not ask him for a cent. If the state feels that it does not want us to be in its debt, and any legislature voluntarily introduces a bill granting us a fee, we shall not oppose it."
