Brownsville, Texas, Aug. 3. - Twelve to fifteen Mexican bandits are reported killed in fighting today with United States cavalrymen and American possemen in the low, thick, thorny brush north of Brownsville.

Appeals have been sent to Governor Ferguson today asking for more United States troops to guard this section of the border. The outlaws are believed to be part of the same band which has been marauding in this section, from 20 to 60 miles inside the American border, for nearly three weeks.
