Wolfe and Morgan County Railroad.

The people of Wolfe and Morgan counties are very enthusiastic over the prospects of securing a railroad from Torrent on the Lexington and Eastern railroad to the coal fields of Morgan. A special from Lexington, of the 13th inst., says: "W. De L. Walbridge, who is representing the New York capitalists who are projecting a new railroad thro' Eastern Kentucky, arrived here this morning from Campton, accompanied by Vice-President Livingston and Engineer Gunn, of the Lexington & Eastern railroad. Mr. Walbridge said the proposed road will penetrate 3,200 acres of the finest cannel coal fields in the world. The road will probably be built. Mr. Walbridge left on the evening train for New York to confer with his associates and report to them the result of his investigation along the routes of the proposed road.—Mt. Sterling Sentinel-Democrat.
