Kentucky Census Figures.
A census bulletin issued Tuesday of last week gives the population of Kentucky by sex, nativity and color. Of a total population of 2,147,174 the males number 1,090,227, a slight excess over the 1,050,947 females; 2,096,925 are native born and 50,249 foreign. Of the 1,862,309 whites 1,812,176 are native born, and only 138,763 of these were born of foreign parents.
The colored population in Kentucky consists of 142,073 males and 142,633 females, and 52 male Indians and 50 females.
In no county do the negroes exceed the whites. The counties having the largest negro population are Jefferson, with 21,430 males and 22,486 females; Christian, with 8,142 males and 8,455 females, and Fayette, with 7,181 males and 8,228 females. Martin county has the smallest negro population—15 all told.
The percentage of males in Kentucky is 50.8 per cent; native born 97.7 per cent; foreign born 2.3 per cent. Of the total population 86.7 per cent are white and 13.3 per cent colored.
