while swinging windows will add to this feature in warm weather.
The lighting is of the indirect system, subdued by inverted shades, suspended from the ceiling.
The operating room is one of the very best in the state with features not found outside the metropolitan cities. It is doubtful if any motion picture theater in Minnesota possesses as spacious an operating room. It is strictly fire proof, concrete floor and side walls, spacious and a model in every respect, in fact a regular room. From the operating room the dimmers will be manipulated.
On the ground floor, off the lobby, there is a private office, large and completely equipped for its purpose.

Ladies' Retiring Room.

One of the really surprising features is the ladies' retiring room, modern in every detail, a large window admitting a view of the interior of the theater where a mother with a fretful babe may retire in seclusion and while quieting the babe view the pictures at the same time.
The main entrance also furnishes a unique feature, in that from the moment a patron steps into the theater he may view the full stage and the picture being run.

The picture screen is set in a pretty frame, in fact a miniature stage with settings of the latest and attractive in detail.
For the opening, Tusch's six-piece orchestra will play and the affair be a notable one in things theatrical in Bemidji.
