London, Dec. 28.—Consternation was caused at the recent St. Andrew's day banquet at the Savoy hotel when it was discovered that the "haggis"—a Scotch delicacy without which no Scottish feast is complete—was missing. Facetious southerners suggested that "the animal" had escaped and was trying to return to Bonnie Scotland through the London fog. Eventually, however, it was found that an ignorant kitchen attendant had mistaken the delicacy for soap, and had sent it to the laundry room. "Haggis" is a weird concoction prepared from the heart, liver and lungs of a sheep or calf cooked in a sheep's stomach bag, after a recipe known only to Highland Scots. It is always brought to the table to the strains of the bagpipes. The Savoy's "haggis" was rescued in time to adorn the festival board although it missed its turn in the course list.

**PHILIPPINES ARE RICH IN NATURAL RESOURCES**

Manila, (By mail to the United Press).—Do the American people know that they own 100,000 square miles of public lands in the Philippines, and that this land is, most of it, tremendously rich in natural resources? One of the first things Governor Wood proposes to do is to reorganize the bureau of lands and get the public domain surveyed and under title.

The democratic acting Governor-General, Charles E. Yeater, speaking in Manila on the eve of his departure, endorsed this proposal and said, "The Philippines can support a population equal to the present population of the United States."

Yeater said that the total land area of the islands is 120,000 square miles, about that of Japan proper; but the Philippines produce big crops the year round, 60 per cent (against 12 per cent in Japan) of the land is tillable, while the forest resources are immeasurably more valuable than those of Japan. He showed that one acre here is equivalent to more than three acres in a temperate climate.

**BUENOS AIRES GROWS**

Buenos Aires, (By mail to the United Press).—During the seven years since the outbreak of the war, notwithstanding almost complete cessation of emigration, the population of Buenos Aires has increased by over 300,000. In the last decade the growth was over 630,000, a truly astonishing figure, as compared with the census of other capitals.

There has been, however, a somewhat disquieting decrease in the birth rate of the city. With a population of 1,692,000, the births were only about 34,000 per annum, whereas in 1914, when the population was much less, these numbered nearly 51,000.

In some cases this decrease is attributed to the high cost of living, the great jump in price taken by necessities, it is alleged, has led to a "strike of mothers."
