

BELONGED TO FAMOUS MAN

Chair Once Used by Primate Bramhall Restored to Place in Cathedral at Armagh.

An ancient chair which was deditated recently at Armagh (Ireland) rathedral by the primate was a treat find, being the oak chair be longing to Primate Bramball, who came into office shortly after Comwell's time. For many years efforts have been made to trace the chair. out it was only a few weeks ago that it was discovered to be in the hands of a well-known London expert. The thair was submitted to a famous antiquarian who at once identified it, with the result that it has returned to its original home—the cathedral. At the top of the chair is carved a large eye -the all-seeing eye; beneath it a rrown after a miter, and under that the arms of the See of Armagh. Under this is the true cross, and below it again 1661-the date on which Archbishop Bramball was enthroned. On the last panel are the capital letters, "M.R.H.," standing for Armagh.
