PEOPLE WHO have been to the gold field and failed to get paying claims are now returning with the declaration that the whole thing is no good. MORAL:—If you have a certain good thing where you are, don't leave it to hunt a fortune in a boom camp.

ANOTHER FAKE mining scheme in New Mexico has drawn large amounts of money from eastern people recently. This sort of work is doing more harm than any one thing we have to contend with and the citizens of the territory should make it so warm for the promoters of all such schemes that they would have to quit business.

A RECENT RIOT occurred in Chicago, when sympathizers of the unions wrecked a street car and seriously injured the non-union men in charge of it. This kind of work on the part of union men and their friends does the labor unions more harm than their opponents possibly can do, and will be the means of breaking up all unions if persisted in.

THE GENERAL activity of building in Deming continues and it appears that the winter will have no effect on the growth of our town this year. Several new residences are now being built and nearly every week sees a new business established. This is the kind of growth that makes a solid town, in distinction to the boom camp which flourishes today and tomorrow dies.

THE INCREASED amount of work being done in most of the old mining camps of the territory this year will do more in the development of our resources than the few finds of new fields, no matter how rich they may be. The companies operating in several old camps are doing substantial development work and opening up permanent ore bodies which will be regular producers, and this is the class of work that counts.

AN EL PASO newspaper recently sent S. H. Newman and another mining man to the new gold fields of Sierra county, New Mexico, who condemn the "strike" as a rank "fake." They state that they could not even obtain a color of gold from the original claim. Mr. Newman is a man of strong prejudices on any subject, and for that reason perhaps his condemnation should be taken with some degree of allowance. Cripple Creek was condemned by scores of mining men with vastly more experience than Mr. Newman, and so was Tonopah and many other flourishing camps. There was Elizabethtown, Golden, Pinos Altos, Hillsboro and many others that enriched the world by many millions of dollars, and it would not be surprising if many other camps are found equally as good. In early days every bank and in fact every store in the territory was provided with gold scales, which were in constant use. In recent years, however, but little attention has been paid to placer mining and now when a little gold is struck people go wild with excitement. The gold, however, is there and the miners are taking it out.

A DEMING LADY recently received a letter from a relative in Cripple Creek, Colorado, which describes the condition of affairs there as "awful." Speaking from the point of view of a citizen who is interested in neither side, she says all mines are working and there is no chance for the old employes to get back, yet they stay and commit depredations of the worst kind. She says: "We are just living in fear, not knowing what will happen next. Martial law is now in force and we hope that will give us protection." In another place she says: "We would leave if we could get away, but we cannot, so we must stay and live it out." In addition to this statement of the condition, she states that property values have gone to nothing and that the taxes will be something terrible. Such state of affairs as this cannot be permitted to continue for any length of time in a state without driving a large number of the best citizens out of the state, and the state will be a great loser thereby. These facts coming from other states prove the wisdom of our little governor in issuing the order he did in regard to disturbances in case of the coal strike and thus preventing any such trouble in New Mexico.
