

LARRY BURNS DING.

SHOOTS HIMSELF WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF LIQUOR.

HELD REVOLVER TO HIS HEAD.

WAS SECRETARY TO L. E. IRWIN WHEN HE WAS CHIEF.

Burns Went to Central Police Station Early in the Evening and Claimed That He Had Been Robbed—Police Investigated—Story Was False.

"Larry" J. Burns, who was secretary to the late ex-Chief of Police L. E. Irwin, made a probably successful attempt to end his own life in his home at 2221 Bellefontaine avenue at 12:10 o'clock this morning. While lying on the kitchen floor he held a .38-caliber revolver against his head and pulled the trigger. The bullet entered his head about two inches back of his right ear, and, ranging upward, passed within a hair's breadth of his brain.

The sound of the shot aroused the household, and Mrs. Burns, who had not yet retired, rushed into the kitchen from an adjoining room and stumbled across the body of her husband. Her piercing screams aroused the neighborhood, and a call was sent to Central police station for a surgeon. Surgeon Landon and the ambulance were dispatched to the scene. Burns was unconscious and bleeding freely when the surgeon arrived. Dr. Landon gave it as his opinion that Burns cannot live. He has been unconscious from the time of the shooting, and seemed to be growing weaker when he was placed in the ambulance to be taken to the city hospital.

Burns was despondent. He had spent the early part of the night drinking in the saloons. For the past two weeks, it was said, he was never suspected that he meditated ending his own existence. He appeared to be more despondent than usual when he left home last night to go down town. His wife heard him when he opened the kitchen door shortly after midnight, but did not go to meet him, as she thought he would come into the parlor, where she was waiting for him. Instead, Larry took a pillow from the sofa and, using it as a headrest, fired the shot that will in all probability terminate his life.

Burns visited Central police station about 5 o'clock last night. He had been drinking, apparently. He greeted the officers on watch and then walked over to the newspaper reporters' corner, and leaning on the railing, talked to them about a newspaper venture, which, he said, was soon to be launched in this city. He said that a new daily was to be started, that he had taken stock in the concern and would be given a permanent position. He seemed to be very hopeful, and gave no intimation by his acts or his conversation that he at that time contemplated doing violence to himself. He left the station before 9 o'clock, but reappeared again shortly after 11 o'clock. He had had several drinks during his absence, and talked of little except the new enterprise. He did say, however, that last night was the first time he had taken a drop of whiskey in seven months, which caused one of the officers to observe that Larry's memory must be getting defective. "Larry" Burns is a friend of James Burns, the capitalist of 715 Forest avenue, who was custodian of the government gold during the late war, and who was in charge of the arrangements in that city has declined to endow ten beds in different hospitals.

BARNES MORE WORRIED.

CHARGES ARE GIVING THEM NO END OF TROUBLE.

APPOINTMENT IS HUNG UP.

SEAY TO BE TURNED IF BARNES IS URGED DOWN.

Anti-Barnes Men Say They Will Carry Their Fight into the Senate If Barnes Is Appointed Governor—Pie Counter Notes.

Washington, April 21.—(Special.) The fight against the appointment of C. M. Barnes as governor of Oklahoma is waxing fiercer. C. C. Holland, of Guthrie, who came on to Washington especially to oppose his appointment, had an interview with the president this morning. As a result, the nomination is being suspended until it is seen that the president will make a thorough examination of the records affecting Mr. Barnes' deal with the typewriter operatives when he was receiver of Guthrie. It is believed that his name will not yet be made their identity known by the affidavits relating to Mr. Barnes' private character. Among other things, it is intimated that he has been hand in glove with the gambling element of the territory. Charges are also promulgated affecting the connection of Barnes and Powell Clayton with the "sons" who broke into Oklahoma before the rest of the boomers had been admitted, and were thus enabled to bobble up valuable townships.

MAN CARELESS DEPOSITORS.

They Fail to Prove Their Claims and Will Be Delayed in Getting Their Money.

Several hundred Missouri National bank depositors yesterday received their checks for the 40 cent dividend declared by the controller of the currency, and the crowd of depositors who were kept busy all day. The crowds were greater in the morning than during the afternoon, and a long line was waiting most of the day for the money. Many of the depositors for their checks who have not yet proven their claims.
