ALL MARKETS WERE DULL. TRADING IN THE WHEAT PIT REMARKABLY LIGHT YESTERDAY.

Close Was at an Advance of 3-4. Due to Higher Cables-Corn and Oats Almost Unchanged-Flour Provisions Off.

Chicago, Nov. 23.-Grain and provision markets were all remarkable to-day for their dullness. A jump in Liverpool cables caused an advance in wheat and that was the only time the market showed a sign of even moderate activity.

It needed constant effort on the part of traders to keep any life in the wheat trade, and business was seldom smaller than it related to the advance. Some degree of activity at the opening. Liverpool opened 1/2 higher for spot wheat and 3/4 up for futures.

Export sales at the seaboard Monday were as follows: 15,000 bushels of wheat for export, 10,000 bushels of corn, 10,000 bushels of oats at New York, and 18,000 bushels of corn and 9,000 bushels of oats at other ports.

The primary market receipts for yesterday were 125,000 bushels of wheat, 100,000 bushels of corn, and 50,000 bushels of oats. The Liverpool opening, however, was responsible for a 1/2 cent advance in wheat.

New York reported a fair export inquiry and twenty-two boats were worked for export there and reports of a 1/2 cent advance from the close. The fly in the ointment of the bull situation was, as before, the heavy domestic receipts.

Outside of a small amount of changing over of December, there was little done in wheat. The former price was held and the latter was 1/2 cent higher.
