CONGREGATIONS DECIDE TO BUILD A NEW HOUSE OF WORSHIP.

The fathers are sorely perplexed over an effort to have a sidewalk laid on the north side of Fifteenth street from Delaware to the home of Ruffner Smith. Several petitions and counter-petitions have been filed and many amendments thereto made by the city council.

CONGREGATIONS DECIDE TO BUILD A NEW HOUSE OF WORSHIP.

After an animated discussion over the matter, the congregation of B'nai Jehudah last evening decided to build a new temple, and a subscription being opened, nineteen of those present subscribed liberally to the fund for that purpose in amounts ranging from \$25 up to \$500 each.

The discussion brought out the fact that nearly all the members think the present temple is too small for the requirements of the Jewish people and that a new and larger temple is needed. Some think, however, that it is unwise for the congregation to attempt a new building at present.
