

THE CURSE OF LIQUOR.

Prohibition Does Not Seem to Check Its Deadly Use.

Liquor caused 258 out of 630 homicides in Alabama during the two years ending September 30 last, according to the biennial report of Attorney General Alex. M. Garber.

"In addition to the increase in the number of homicides due to the use of intoxicating liquor by a population almost equally divided between whites and negroes, in a climate which aggregates the effect of such use," the Attorney General says, "I would say that there may be assigned as further reasons contributing to the unfortunate and deplorable homicide record of Alabama.

"First, a general prolific source of crime among the negro population.

"Second, the natural conflict, or friction, growing out of business and other necessary relations between two races essentially dissimilar in characteristics and widely separated in social life.

"And third, the racial characteristic of the Southern name to resent quickly an insult and to act upon slight provocation, especially in matters involving personal honor."

MYSTERY SURROUNDS DEATH

Of a Young Engaged Couple in the Young Woman's Home.

The fact that he had in his pocket at the time of his death a railroad mileage book is considered, by State's Attorney David A. Robb, good reason to believe that Charles E. Twigg, of Keyser, W. Va., did not commit suicide. Relatives and friends of Miss Grace Ellosser are equally positive that she was not a victim of self-murder.

The authorities are, up to this time, positive only that the bodies of these two, who were to have been married Sunday night, were found seated on a sofa in the parlor of the Ellosser home by the girl's mother on Saturday afternoon; that they died from the effects of cyanide of potassium, of which the man swallowed more than did the girl. They are to examine the remainder of a box of candy, from which all the members of the Ellosser family are said to have eaten.

They will also test some chewing gum found in the house. They know that Twigg had a piece of chewing gum in his mouth when he was found dead. Little or nothing is expected in the way of developments until after the two funerals, which will take place at Cumberland, Md., where the double tragedy took place.

Attempt at Suicide.

Ex-Judge Spencer B. Adams, of Greensboro, N. C., attempted to end his life last night, using as the weapon of attempted self-destruction a razor. Judge Adams was State chairman of the Republican executive committee for several years.
