### TWELVE RESERVE DISTRICTS.

Organization Committee Completes Ordering System—Places South Carolina in Region of Virginia.

Washington, April 2.—After three months of consideration the reserve bank organization committee tonight announced that it had divided the continental United States into 12 banking districts and selected 12 cities for federal reserve banks under the new currency law. This was the first decisive step toward the establishment of the new system. The cities and districts are:

District No. 1, Boston—Reserve bank will have capital of \$9,931,740, with 446 national banks as members. Territory included, New England States.

District No. 2, New York—Capital \$20,687,616, with 478 national and a number of State banks (not given) as members. Territory, State of New York.

District No. 3, Philadelphia—Capital \$12,993,013, including 800 national banks and several State banks. Territory, New Jersey and Delaware and all Pennsylvania, east of western boundary of following counties: McKean, Elk, Clearfield, Cambria and Bedford.

District No. 4, Cleveland—Capital \$11,621,535, with 724 national and several State banks. Territory, State of Ohio, all Pennsylvania lying west of district No. 3, the counties of Marshall, Ohio, Brooke and Hancock in West Virginia and all Kentucky east of the western boundary of the following counties: Boone, Grant, Scott, Woodford, Jessamine, Garrard, Lincoln, Pulaski and McCreary.

**Richmond District.**  
District No. 5, Richmond—Capital \$6,543,281, with 475 national banks and a number of State banks and trust companies. Territory: District of Columbia, Maryland, Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina and all West Virginia except those counties in district 4.

District No. 6, Atlanta—Capital \$4,702,780, with 372 national banks, etc. Territory, Alabama, Georgia, Florida, all Tennessee east of the western boundary of the following counties: Stewart, Houston, Wayne, Humphreys and Perry; all Mississippi south of the northern boundary of the following counties: Issaquena, Sharkey, Yazoo, Kemper, Madison, Leake and Neshoba; all of the southeastern part of Louisiana east of the western boundary of the following counties: Poincane, Iberville, Assumption and Terrebonne.

District No. 7, Chicago—Capital, \$13,151,925, with 984 national banks, etc. Territory, Iowa, all Wisconsin south of the northern boundary of the following counties: Vernon, Sauk, Columbia, Dodge, Washington and Osaukee; all of the southern peninsula of Michigan, viz: All that part of Lake Michigan; all Illinois north of a line forming the southern boundary of the following counties: Hancock, Schuyler, Cass, Sangamon, Christian, Shelby, Cumberland and Clark; all Indiana north of a line forming the southern boundary of the following counties: Vigo, Clay, Owen, Monroe, Brown, Bartholomew, Jennings, Ripley and

District No. 8, St. Louis—Capital \$6,219,323 with 434 national banks, etc. Territory, Arkansas, all Missouri east of the western boundary of the following counties: Harrison, Daviess, Caldwell, Ray, Lafayette, Johnson, Honey, St. Clair, Cedar, Dade Lawrence and Barry; all Illinois not included in district 7; all Indiana not in district 7; all Kentucky not in district 4; all Tennessee not in district 6, and all Mississippi not in district 6.

District No. 9, Minneapolis—Capital \$4,702,764, with 687 national banks, etc. Territory, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Minnesota, all Wisconsin and all Michigan not in district 7.

District No. 10, Kansas City—Capital \$5,594,916, with 835 national banks, etc. Territory, Kansas, Nebraska, Colorado, Wyoming, all of Missouri not in district No. 8; all Oklahoma north of a line forming the south boundary of the following counties: Ellis, Dewey, Blaine, Canadian, Cleveland, Pottawatomie, Seminole, Okfuskee, McIntosh, Muskogee and Sequoyah, all New Mexico east of a line forming the southern boundary of the following counties: McKinley, Sandoval, Santa Fe, San Miguel and Union.

**Texas District.**

District No. 11, Dallas—Capital \$5,634,091, with 726 national banks, etc. Territory, Texas, all New Mexico and Oklahoma not in district 10; all Louisiana not in district No. 6 and the following counties in Arizona: Pima, Graham, Greenelee, Cochise and Santa Cruz.

District No. 12, San Francisco—Capital \$8,115,524, with 214 national banks, etc. Territory, California, Washington, Oregon, Idaho, Nevada and Utah, and all Arizona not included in district 11.

### HOMICIDE NEAR LEXINGTON.

G. Levi Rish, a Prominent Farmer, Shot to Death at School Crossing.

Lexington, April 4.—G. Levi Rish, a prominent farmer of Lexington county, was shot and instantly killed at Smith Branch school house, 20 miles south of this city, at 10 o'clock tonight. James Clark and Elliott Gaunt, two well-known farmers, are accused of the crime, according to a message received here by Sheriff Miller at 11 o'clock. Details of the tragedy at this hour are meagre and hard

to obtain because of the fact that there is but one telephone line to the community in which the shooting occurred. According to reports Rish, Clark and Gaunt met at the school house, where there was an entertainment in progress in connection with the closing of the school. The killing occurred just outside the building and seven or eight shots are said to have been fired. One bullet struck Rish in the head, causing instant death. The deceased was a man of about 38 years of age and is survived by a wife and four children. Sheriff Miller and the coroner have left for the scene.

### MEANT TO SHOOT AT MAN, BUT KILLED LITTLE BOY

Sad Tragedy at St. Stephens Follows Altercation Between Two White Men.

St. Stephen, April 4.—In a difficulty this afternoon between R. E. Briscoe and Ben Bradley, both of this place, Briscoe, it is said, in attempting to shoot Bradley, fired the gun and killed the little son of Mr. and Mrs. H. A. Jaudon instantly. The little fellow received the whole load of shot intended for Bradley in his breast. Bradley saved himself by catching hold of the muzzle of the gun. He lost almost the entire hand, it being shot away by the same load that killed the child. The boy was about 7 years of age and a fine little fellow. The family is prostrated with grief. Briscoe was taken in charge by the police and was taken to jail by the sheriff. Excitement was very high, but violence was prevented by cooler heads. The little fellow was well known in the town and will be sadly missed. The heartfelt sympathy of the entire people of the town is extended to the bereaved family.
