NEGLECT OF PIGS IS FATAL

Slight Mistake in Feeding or Watering May Prove Disastrous—Always Exercise Great Care.

Many a fine litter of pigs is lost by a little neglect at a critical time. A slight mistake in feeding or watering the sow may prove fatal to the young pigs, and the greatest care should be exercised to insure against loss.

Even a cold drink given to the sow after farrowing often proves fatal to the pigs, and all liquid given to the sow for a day or two after farrowing should be slightly warmed, so that the chill is removed. For the first twenty-four hours after farrowing give the sow no solid food; a warm drink with a handful of ground oats, shorts or bran to color the water is all that is necessary.

The second day the drink should be made somewhat thicker, gradually increasing the allowance to keep pace with the demands of the litter. Should the sow lose a little flesh in the beginning, all the better, for the danger lies in overfeeding, thereby causing fever, which is quickly transmitted to the pigs.

A light, cooling diet is demanded, and as the pigs become older and require more sustenance the food can be increased until the sow is on a full nutritious ration.

GENERAL FARM NOTES

Now get the early pullets into winter quarters and feed them for eggs.

It never pays to allow any animal to go into the winter in a poor condition.

When not too expensive, potatoes may be fed to cows in limited quantities.

The best pigs are the offspring of mature mothers and vigorous young sires.

If there were fewer whips in the world there would be fewer ugly horses.

A brood sow should have length of body, but not too high from the ground.

Arrange the feed and feeding places so as to have all things convenient.

Nothing is so well calculated to make pigs grow as a bountiful supply of sow's milk.

In the fall is a good time to top dress the lawn with a good application of well rotted manure.

Dampness in the poultry house will cause lots of trouble. Therefore, make the roof tight so that it will be dry.

A lot of extra male birds will fight among themselves and worry the rest of the flock and had better be disposed of.

DETERMINING A COW'S VALUE

Important Fact Can Only Be Found Out by Weighing Each Milking and Keeping Daily Record.

The value of a cow can only be known by weighing each milking and keeping a daily record of the same. The weighing of the feed and the weighing of the milk is now followed by expert dairymen.

Sometimes a good cow is not appreciated because the yield comes from her months of milking rather than from the big yield soon after calving. A dairymen at a farmers' meeting a few weeks ago said: "I have introduced the system of weighing the grain and forage fed to the herd and weighing the milk of each cow. It takes very little time to do this, and you can then know after a few months what cows are the most profitable."

A persistent milker will in most every instance prove the most profitable cow to keep.

The Danish dairymen raise what cows they need. The most profitable cows can only be had by careful breeding, wise selection, practical feeding and thorough milking. In some dairies the young cows are milked three times a day to develop their milking qualities.

Valuable Winter Feed.

Unthreshed peas may be made a valuable winter feed for hogs by leaving the crop in the field until the vines are well cured, when they are gathered without being cut with the common bull rake used in haying. There are a few vines left where the rake starts, but as soon as a quantity has gathered upon the teeth they are taken up clean with but little scattering. They may be fed from the stack during the winter without threshing.

Small Fruits.

Both currants and gooseberries thrive in limestone soils, provided the climate is not too warm. Both of these small fruits are cool-weather crops and demand fertile soils. There is an increasing demand among canneries for these fruits.
