Notice is hereby given that the books for Dillon county will be open for the collection of taxes from Oct. 15th, 1910 to March 15th, 1911.

The following penalties will be added:

January, one per cent., February, two per cent., March, seven per cent.

All persons between the ages of 21 and 60, except Confederate soldiers and those otherwise exempt by law are liable for poll tax.

The commutation of two dollars (2.00) can be paid till March 1st, 1911. All persons between the ages of 21 and 65 are liable.

The state, county and 3 mile constitutional is 13 3-4.

TAX RETURNS.

The Auditor's office will be open for taking tax returns from January 1st to February 20th, 1911.

The law requires that the property be listed for taxes this year, including personal property, notes, mortgage moneys, etc. also an income tax on income of \$2,500.00 and upwards, and all real estate that has been transferred from one party to another since last return.

There shall be a capitation tax of 50 cents on all dogs, the proceeds to be expended for school purposes. Dogs not returned for taxation shall not be held to be property in any of the courts of the State.

All males between the ages of 21 and 60 years, except Confederate soldiers or those persons incapable of earning a support by being maimed or from any other cause are liable to poll tax.

All property must be assessed at its true value in money, which is construed to mean "the sum at which said property under ordinary circumstances would sell for cash."

Don't ask that your property be taken from the books the same as last year.

All property must be listed on proper blanks and sworn to. Township and number of school district must be given.

The auditor or his deputy will be at the following places on the dates mentioned below to take tax returns:

- Judson, Tuesday, January 31, 1911.

- Centerville, Thursday, February 2, p. m., 1911.
- Fore, Friday, February 3, 1911.
- Hamer, Monday, February 6, 1911.
- Gaddys Mill, Tuesday, February 7, 1911.
- Second Week, February 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th, 19th, 20th, 1911.

It is hoped that all will meet the auditor promptly and make their returns and thereby avoid the 50 per cent. penalty.
