TRAXLER STILL RETAINS JOB.

Reported Greenville Postmaster Has Withdrawn Resignation.

Greenville, September 13.—A political sensation was created here this afternoon when it was stated that David B. Traxler had succeeded in withdrawing his resignation as postmaster at Greenville, which he filed in July to become a candidate for congress against Congressman Nicholls, of the 4th district.

Early street rumors that Mr. Traxler had been "reinstated" were given little credence until confirmed tonight in telegrams sent by Congressman Nicholls to certain applicants for the postmastership. Mr. Nicholls contends, substantially, that as late as two days ago he was led to believe by statements from Postmaster General Burleson that Traxler could not withdraw his resignation.

Ordered Back to Work.
He says he was informed today by the first assistant postmaster general that Traxler had been ordered to go back to his job immediately, as the withdrawal of his resignation had been agreed to. Congressman Nicholls telegraphed that he was told by the department that these were orders from Mr. Burleson, and he add-

Big Elephant is Hanged in Tennessee Because of Violent Outbreaks.

Erwin, Tenn., Sept. 1.—"Mary," the big elephant which Tuesday killed her trainer at Kingsport, Tenn., after a circus performance, was hanged here today in the presence of more than 1,500 persons. The animal was forced on to a derrick car by other elephants, heavy chains were tied around her neck and she was suspended in the air. According to her owners she was valued at \$20,000.

The hanging was decided upon, it was said, because of many outbreaks of the animal.
