WAR SHIPS IN HAYTI PRODUCE DESIRED EFFECT.

Paris, Mar. 18.—Official advices from Hayti indicate that the arrival at Port au Prince of foreign war ships has produced the desired effect upon President Alexis. French Minister Carteron cables that the Haytien government has abandoned its blood-thirsty attitude, that the re-embarkment of refugees has been authorized and safe conducts have been granted for the departure of Gen. Firmin and other revolutionists who have taken asylum at the legations and consulates. All danger of an attack on the consulates is considered at an end.
