DEFACING POLL LISTS CHARGE AGAINST EDITOR

Cherokee, February 2.—Editor Charles L. Wilson was indicted at the special session of the grand jury for alleged defacing of poll lists. The cause was due to the fight for a county seat in Alfalfa county, and dates back some little time.

The editor of the Messenger gives a half column to his detractors and some of it is what a base ball player would term "too hot to handle," but the opening statement is herewith produced.

"The grand jury which was empaneled through the efforts of Duff Jugeloff and a few other conspirators, made their report last Friday night, and it revealed that the editor of this paper, C. L. Wilson, W. H. Pfaff and G. W. Wood, had been indicted, charged with defacing poll lists.
