If Williams Does Not Appoint Association's Choice His Action Will Be Legal.

COMMISSION JOB IS GOSSIP

It is possible that the full force and power of the Oklahoma constitution precluding an invasion of its rights by any act of the legislature could be brought out in the matter of the selection of the next banking commissioner...

That the present banking law, passed at last session of the legislature, is obviously in conflict with the constitution, is now claimed, and there seems ground for such contention.

Law Not Followed.

It is a well established condition that the legislature cannot enact a law in conflict with the constitution, nor can the constitution be amended without submitting such an amendment to a vote of the people.

It will be the duty of the incoming governor to name the bank commissioner to succeed J. D. Lankford, appointed by Governor Cruce four years ago.

While the new law practically placed the regulation of the state banks and the management of the guaranty fund in the hands of the state bankers' association...

If the contingencies cited bring the situation to an issue it is possible that the bankers will again get busy during the coming legislature and seek to amend the constitution...

MORE OR LESS PAY URGED BY MAHR FOR HEALTH JOB

The position of state commissioner of health should not be treated as a place suitable to serve a reward for political service rendered, for \$1500 a year is too much for a political position, but is altogether too little for the service of a full-time, well-trained and efficient health officer.

Dr. J. H. Mahr, present state health commissioner, makes this recommendation in his biennial report to Governor Cruce, together with other suggestions which will be transmitted to the legislature when it convenes next month.

Particular attention is called to the value of precautionary measures for contagious diseases, such as smallpox, and other preventable diseases. Vaccination for small pox and typhoid fever is urged. This is done now in the United States army and it has had a wonderful effect in reducing the number of cases of these diseases among the soldiers.

ducts for use in such cases has done a wonderful amount of good.

System Unsatisfactory. From the fact that only practicing physicians are required to report contagious and infectious diseases, and births and deaths the system for securing vital statistics in Oklahoma is far from satisfactory, says Dr. Mahr.

Abolishment of quarantine for smallpox is recommended and vaccination to prevent the disease is suggested. The quarantine cannot successfully be enforced, and "the man who does not want to have smallpox or have it in his family can protect himself and family by vaccination, which is cheap and the most satisfactory means of protection."

Recommendations requiring appropriations are: State commissioner of health, \$1500; chief clerk and statistical clerk, \$1500; stenographer and book-keeper, \$1200; drug inspector, \$1200; stenographer and clerk pure food and drug division, \$600; contagious and infectious disease fund for board of health, \$500; biological products, \$7500; contingent fund pure food and drug division, \$3000; prairie fund state board of health, \$2,500.

Suggestion to Save. Relative to the chemical analysis in which the services of the state chemist are not required, Dr. Mahr makes this recommendation: "Real economy to the state could be practiced if both the food and drug inspectors were required to be competent and efficient chemists, and the laboratory for pure food and drug work maintained in connection with the office of the state board of health, these inspectors making their own analysis. Seven or eight hundred dollars would be ample provision for all things necessary in the way of laboratory equipment and supplies to do this work successfully, and it would be a decided improvement over present arrangements."

METHODIST MINISTER SAID TO BE OLDEST, IS DEAD. Middlebury, Vt., Dec. 14.—Rev. Sedgwick W. Bidwell, said to be the oldest Methodist minister in the country, is dead at the age of 105 years. He had lived in East Middlebury since his retirement after three-quarters of a century of service as a clergyman. He celebrated his 100th anniversary on December 6, 1900 by delivering a sermon in the village church.
