Passengers arriving on Friday's train from Nazca report that they passed approximately one thousand cavalrymen of the command of General Arnaldo Gomez riding northward.



LAW TO BLOCKADE TINY FOLK MAKE BOOZE RUNNERS HIT ON PROGRAM

BARTLESVILLE, Okla., April 1.—(Special.)—Kansas authorities are taking steps to put a stop to the booze runners carrying liquor from Joplin into north-eastern Oklahoma.

An organized appeal from Montgomery, LaBette and Cherokee counties has been sent to Fred Robertson, United States district attorney for Kansas, asking him to aid in stopping smuggling of liquor through those counties and thence into the Indian country of Oklahoma.

Since the railroads have refused to accept shipments of liquor into this Indian country, motor trucks and automobiles have been substituted, which load at Joplin and speed by night through Kansas into Oklahoma.
