



Collision and Loss of Life. Baltimore, September 2.—A collision occurred at Highland Park Station, on the Western Maryland railroad this morning, between the regular and extra freight trains. The regular train was on account of a box, and a moment after was run in by the extra. A brakeman had gone back to the extra. Cruise, engineer of the extra, jumped and escaped with a strained ankle. Abel, a brakeman, was killed; Joseph Dorsey, cattle driver, fatally injured; Wm. Fleigh, fireman, slightly injured. The verdict of the coroner's jury charged the collision to gross negligence.

DODGE CITY. The Wicked Town Receives its First Taste of Sunday Quiet. Dodge City, Kan., September 2.—For the first time since there was a Dodge City we had the serenity of a Sunday. All business houses, saloons, dance halls and gambling halls were closed to-day, showing some regard for the Sabbath. There is universal rejoicing over this, and it is felt that measures of reform as contemplated by the city council will be carried out. Many gamblers and prostitutes are leaving.


