JACK THE RIPPER'S VICTIM.

The Woman Not One of the Whitechapel Class—Her Throat Cut.

LONDON, Oct. 25.—The body of the woman found murdered in the South Hemstead locality last night shows that the crime bears no resemblance to those committed by "Jack the Ripper," and medical examination of the remains proves that the woman did not belong to

the Whitechapel class, from which the "Ripper" selected his victims. The body is that of a woman about thirty years of age, and was well clad. Her linen was marked, her throat had been cut and her skull fractured, and all the pockets in her clothing were empty. A perambulator containing a blood-stained fur rug was found near by, which it is supposed was used to convey the body from the spot where the crime was committed to where it was found.

FIRE BUGS.

The East Pepperell, Mass., Conflagration Evicted of Incendiary Origin.—BOSTON, Mass., Oct. 25.—A special from East Pepperell, Mass., says that the visitation of flame which desolated a large portion of this town yesterday was the work of an incendiary is pretty well established. The wire which connected the burned factory with three of the alarm bells was so cut that no signal of the conflagration could be given until the fire had gained great headway. The hose used by the department of the Fairchild's mills was clogged up by stones, and the keyholes in the doors of the quarters of the North engine company were plugged up, making it necessary to force the windows to get the apparatus out. No one understands the motive of the crime, if such it was.

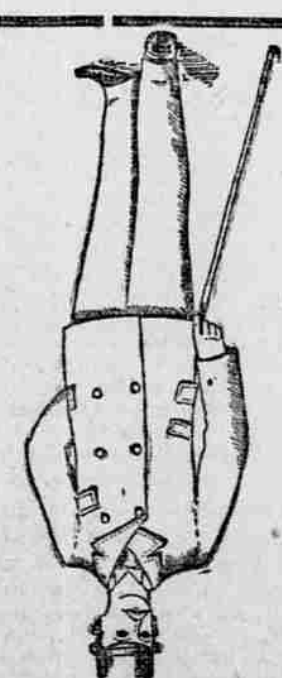
