A KENTUCKY MAN.

Nicholas Davis, Third Cavalry, Barrened Himself in a Room, Imagining He Was Assaulted.

Washington, Dec. 16.—Nicholas Davis, of Kentucky, a member of troop B, third cavalry, regulars, now stationed at Fort Meyer, Va., who had been drinking heavily, armed with a Krag-Jorgensen rifle and several hundred rounds of ammunition, barricaded himself in an upper room of the company quarters. He imagined the place was assailed, opened all the windows commanding the various approaches and proceeded to shoot aimlessly about. Bullets flew in all directions until the colonel gave orders to a sergeant to take a guard and shoot Davis. The sergeant obeyed, but instead of ordering the guard to fire did so himself. The bullet struck the butt of Davis' rifle, shattering it. The flying splinters knocked Davis senseless and scarred his face somewhat, though giving him no very serious injury. He is now closely confined and receiving treatment.

A Silver Jubilee.

Louisville, Ky., Dec. 16.—The silver jubilee of the Christian Foreign Missionary society was celebrated here Friday. Leaders of that denomination were present from Kentucky, Ohio, Indiana and Missouri, including Dr. A. McLean, of Cincinnati; Hon. W. S. Dickinson, of Cincinnati, first treasurer of the society; Dr. J. H. Garrison, of St. Louis, and Dr. E. E. Pound, of Cleveland. The societies have over 200 missionaries scattered throughout the world.

Gamblers Heavily Fined.

Lexington, Ky., Dec. 16.—The proprietors of gambling houses in Lexington paid into the circuit court Friday \$3,950 in fines. John Pike paid \$1,000, and secured the quashing of a felony indictment by promising not to run his machines again here. Eight saloon-keepers paid \$200 each for permitting gambling devices on their premises.

James Bronston Injured.

Richmond, Ky., Dec. 16.—James Bronston, half-brother of State Senator Chas. J. Bronston, of Lexington, was hit on the head by unknown parties and seriously, if not fatally, hurt. Ex-Deputy Sheriff J. Gordon Dudley and brother Herndon have been arrested, charged with assault. Cause of trouble not known.

Money Hid in the Bed.

Richmond, Ky., Dec. 16.—Rev. I. T. Sams, living on Hardwick creek, East Hill county, had \$634 in cash stolen from his house a few days ago by unknown parties. Rev. Sams did not believe placing his money in banks, but it concealed in a feather bed.

All Were Discharged.

Louisville, Ky., Dec. 16.—Four men charged with the murder of Riney Boley, and four charged with being accessories, were dismissed Friday morning. The killing occurred Sunday, and it was shown that Boley was trying to kill John Banks, because he informed on a friend.

Kentucky Trotting Futurity.

Lexington, Ky., Dec. 16.—Secretary Horace W. Wilson, of the Kentucky Trotting Horse Breeders' association, Friday night announced the 11th renewal of the Kentucky Futurity, valued at \$20,000, and to close March 15 next at a fee of \$5 per mare.

Twenty-Seventh District Judgeship. Frankfort, Ky., Dec. 16.—The meeting of the state election commission, to have been held Friday to pass on the question of giving a certificate to John H. Wilson, as judge of the 27th judicial district, has been indefinitely postponed.

The Case Again Continued.

Barboursville, Ky., Dec. 16.—The trial of Dee Baker, the Clay equity feudist charged, with complicity in the murder of Will White, was again continued Friday morning. On account of Baker's illness it was continued in July.

Wilder Can Not Recover.

London, Ky., Dec. 16.—A report from Manchester says John Wilder, who was shot there Monday in a general street fight, can not recover. It is asserted by the other side that Dempsey Wilder, John's father, fired the shot, which accidentally struck the son.

Distillery Sale Reported.

Louisville, Ky., Dec. 16.—D. Meschenhoff, proprietor of the Old Kentucky distillery, is said to have purchased the Fible & Crabb distillery, at Eminence, for use in the manufacture of private brands.

Were Remarried.

Franklin, Ky., Dec. 16.—G. L. London and Mrs. Nannie London, who were married 27 years ago, and divorced seven years ago, have settled their differences and were remarried by Rev. Chandler.

Ex-Gov. Bradley's Present.

Frankfort, Ky., Dec. 16.—Employer of the state house Friday presented ex-Gov. Bradley with the chair and couch that he has used during his four years as governor. The purchase was made from the state.

Big Steel Steamer Wrecked.

Chicago, Dec. 16.—News reached here Friday that the big steel steamer Arthur Orr is wrecked on the rocks at the entrance of Georgian bay. Cove island is over 30 miles from any point of communication. The news came from Owen sound. Tugs were immediately sent from Port Huron to the wreck. It is reported that the vessel is in an exposed position, and will be badly damaged if not speedily released. The vessel cost \$200,000.
