TEACHERS' INSTITUTE

Yesterday's Sessions at the Court-house Well Attended—
Day's Doings

MORNING SESSION.
Superintendent C. D. Wells opened the Mason County Teachers' Institute at the Court-house at 9 o'clock yesterday morning with the usual exercises, Prof. R. M. Shipp reading the third chapter of James and leading in prayer.

"Grammar" was the first subject presented by Prof. Shipp, which led to a spirited discussion, participated in by a number of the teachers.

After a short recess Mr. Vincent was again given an opportunity to present the claims of his publications.

Miss Dye's next number on the program was "Habit and Will," her remarks in part following—

"Habit is the strongest educational ally. A common sense definition may be 'a tendency to repeat what has once been performed.' The definition in psychology is that 'habits are due to pathways of discharge through nerve centers.' Correct habits distinguish the trained from the untrained mind. The trained mind enables one to work under pressure without impediment; to create one's own mood, find one's own cue and handle new data. The untrained mind can do none of these things. Aside from this, correct habits are the great economizers in life. They save mental waste, strengthen the mental powers by leaving the mind free to do its own work, they lessen fatigue and make for freedom. Correct habits can be cultivated in school by an atmosphere of confidence furnished by the teacher by leading the child to see and act in harmony with the situation, and to see that children begin to think for themselves.

"Will: A trained will, tempered by good judgment and right feelings, is the consummation of discipline in school life. Will is reinforced by habit. Will is that mental activity that decides, that chooses and sends forth the fiat—the order to do. It is in the exercise of the will that man becomes an ethical being. There can be no training of the will without an exercise in the right of choice. To choose the painful right and carry it out is the mark of a trained

will. The school affords ample opportunity for the cultivation of the will, but perhaps it does less along this line than any other. The will takes its start in interest and when the interest is employed the will works normally. The school that would send forth students who will in time make the best men and women must see to it that the will receives its share of training in early life."

The singing of "Throw Out the Life Line" opened the Institute at 1:30.

Prof. Shipp spoke on "Spelling," on which he gave some good points to the teachers.

Miss Dye again took up her talk on Tap-root Stories, confining her thoughts to Greek Literature. "The Iliad" and "The Odyssey" were spoken of at length, and throughout Miss Dye was listened to with strict attention.

After a short recess Prof. Shipp continued his talk on "Spelling."
