Postoffices of the 3rd class, will be quickly busy places throughout the month of May. The Dept. at Washington has issued orders for an extensive and accurate count of every piece of mail matter handled at Postoffices throughout the country. This means a gigantic undertaking for an office like the Richmond office. It will cause double work and make delays unavoidable. All outgoing mails will have to be closed earlier and all incoming mail will necessarily require more time in opening, to permit of the count being thoroughly and accurately made. This is the first time in the history of the local office that such a move has been made by the Department and it means that Postmaster General Hitchcock is making the best official the country has had in a long time. For sometime it has been a yearly duty to weigh all mails, and this new idea is just another way of ascertaining just how much Uncle Sam is doing on the books.

Many of the Automobile owners of Richmond and Madison county must come across next month with their state license, according to a statement sent out last week by Secretary of State Bruner. About 1,500 will fall due the middle of June. According to the records of the department at Frankfort 8,970 owners in Kentucky paid license last year. According to these figures and averaging each machine in the state to be worth 1,000, it can be seen that the enormous sum of nearly \$2,000,000 is tied up in automobiles in the Old Commonwealth. Of this amount between \$40,000 and \$50,000 is represented by autos in Madison county.
