Lice.

Ever since the days of Pharoah our gallinaceous birds have doubtless been more or less plagued with this pestiferous parasite—although it is within the power of their owners to reduce this trouble to a minimum.

During this and the next few months at the time when the hen should naturally rest from her labors and recuperate for the winter egg trade, she is harassed and worried to death by these blood-sucking insects. Many old breeders allow this thing to go on year after year, boasting that their houses are clean and their birds free from lice. But do they look for them? Many do not know when to look and thereby overlook them. To begin with the chick when a few days old, you will find them on the head and under the chin? At this age anoint chick's head and under bill with only lard.

When the chicks are three or four weeks old, you will find them in an entirely different place. At this age the wing feathers are half way out and quills full of blood. Look at the roots of these quill feathers and you will find them sure enough dodging in and out, playing hide and seek. Try lard this time highly seasoned with coal oil or some of your chicks will droop and die. And now for the old hens, examine here and there casually and you see one or two gliding through the feathers; look on the thighs and you find them a little thicker, now turn your hen over and look into the fluff feathers just under the vent and what do you see, holy horrors; lice by the million and countless myriads of eggs cemented together in one solid mass. Use heroic measures at once and aside from soiled feathers your birds will be free from lice in ten days and singing away as of old. Rub well into roots of feathers ointment of sulphur and lard. Also put under wings and thighs and a little all over body.

If you don't want soiled feathers and are willing to take a little more time, buy you a bee-smoker with bellows attached. Fill up the fire box with dry tobacco or rags saturated with sulphur. Set fire to the contents, put the nozzle under the feathers and go to work on the bellows. Smoke good all over and if it does not kill all lice, repeat at intervals. If sulphur is used, protect hen's heads from the fumes by thrusting her in a bag and tie sack around her neck with hole in sack to insert bellows. Follow up these directions and lice with you will be among the things that were.

But a few years ago these birds were very rare and exceedingly expensive. They are now becoming very popular and plentiful. They are the largest of the English family and are most beautiful birds, putting all other birds of this country in the shade for hardness, beauty, eating and multiplying qualities. They are very prolific, and well able to take care of themselves when running wild. They endure the cold winters better than game bird or barnyard fowl of this country, and stand hot climates as well. They are not particular about their diet, will eat roots, buds, vegetables, insects and all kinds of grain. Sportsmen, game merchants, hotels and wealthy citizens are all free purchasers of these beautiful birds. They are strong flyers and swift runners, commence laying about April 15th, and will lay until September 1st, laying from 50 to 75 eggs if well fed. They are easily raised and well worth the time spent with them.

The Chinese Ringneck are just as beautiful, only one third smaller and much wilder. A small hen is the proper thing to hatch the eggs and rear the young. C. F. Dey. Lawton, Mich.




