NEW KENTUCKY HOME

Something About the State Building at St. Louis.

The Kentucky Exhibit Association has adopted the building design of Kenneth McDowell and J. F. Sheblesay, for the St. Louis building which will be called the "New Kentucky Home," and this design was selected after two weeks had been spent in canvassing the twelve different drawings submitted in competition.

The building will cover an area of 138x108 feet, including porches and verandas. The building proper is 97x62 feet. For neighbors it will have California on one side and Minnesota on the other, facing Iowa and New Mexico. The exterior shows a classic style of architecture, richly decorated. It is symmetrically and well balanced. The structure is surrounded by porches and verandas.

Every side of the building is a front, and each, of course, has an entrance. The broad sides of the building are emphasized by massive porches flanked with structural groups, symbolic of mines, forestry, manufactures, agriculture and horticulture.

Unlike many exposition buildings, the "New Kentucky Home" has an inviting interior as it has an attractive exterior. The first floor forms a large reception hall, 56x60 feet, with a hardwood floor. Along the walls of this hall the exhibits will be placed. In the center will be a map of Kentucky made of marble mosaics. It will be twenty-six feet square and will show clearly every county of the State. The mosaics to be colored to indicate the special resources of each county—black for coal, yellow for clay, white for stone, green for fruit, red for wheat, lemon for corn, red for whiskey, brown for timber, gray for asphalt, etc., etc. This big rug will have a border of mosaics working out some pretty design.


