The public school attendance in Arizona averages 10,000, in New Mexico 23,000 and in Oklahoma 35,000. The proportion of population enrolled for school purposes in these territories is 13, 17 and 25 per cent., respectively. In New York, Connecticut and Massachusetts it is 16.

CRANKS IN WASHINGTON.

Great Numbers of Them Attracted by Sessions of Congress.

"Crankers are more numerous than ever," remarked a police official to a Washington Star reporter one afternoon this week after three alleged crazy people had been arrested and held for treatment. "Where they all come from I have no idea," he added. "There are enough insane cases now to keep one man busy all the time, while for many years the man who had charge of such cases handled them in addition to his other work. Seldom a day passes that there are not several cranks to be cared for, and the preparation of their cases requires considerable time."

The official explained that during the session of congress most of the cranks throughout the country head this way because they seem to think that congress can right all wrongs and remedy troubles of every description. It is during the session of congress that they expect they will find the president at home, and many of them call at the white house. Female cranks have increased in number, and they usually cause more trouble than the men. They are more difficult to handle and harder to deceive.

"Tell a woman you are going to take her to see the president and start away from the white house," the official said, "and she will doubt the truth of your statement. Usually she will refuse to go, but the men invariably express a willingness to go and will even go alone if given the proper directions. They are often referred to Sanitary Officer Frank when they call to see the president, and most of them succeed in finding that officer at police headquarters."

"What do you think is the cause for the large increase in the number of cranks?" the police official was asked.

"That's hard to tell," he replied. "I sometimes think it is the result of reading so much trashy literature. There is so much of that sort printed now, and I think the people with weak brains read it and then think over it so much that it drives them crazy."

The Missionary Apple Tree.

In the rectory garden of Pyrford, near Woking, there stands what is familiarly known as the missionary apple tree. The tree is a large one and of a good age, and has been so named for the reason that for many years past it has been the custom of the rector of the parish to collect the fruit, sell it in the best market, and devote the proceeds to the missionary societies of the Church of England. Quite a large sum of money has been raised in this way.
