Metric System.
The fundamental unit of the metric
system is the meter, the unit of length.
It is 39.37 inches. The prefix milli
means one thousandth, cent, one hun-
dredth, deci, one-tenth; deca, ten;
hecto, one hundred; kilo, one thou-
sand. Where miles are used in Eng-
land and the United States for meas-
uring distance the kilometer (1,000
meters) is used in metric countries.
The kilometer is about 5 furlongs.
There are about 1,600 meters in a sta-
tute mile, 20 meters in a chain and 1
meter in a rod. The meter is used
for dry goods, merchandize, engineer-
ing construction, building and other
purposes where the yard and foot are
used. The meter is about a tenth
longer than the yard. The centimeter
and millimeter are used instead of the
inch and its fractions in machine con-
struction and similar work. The cen-
timeter, as its name shows, is the
hundredth of a meter. It is used to
measure work, in expressing sizes of
papers, books and many cases where
the inch is used. The centimeter is
about two-fifths of an inch and the
millimeter about one-twenty-eighth of
an inch. The millimeter is divided for
finer work into tenths, hundredths and
thousandths.
