sent and got my good friend, L. W. Bethurum. The town marshal had gone out in the country and summoned about ten good discreet citizens and had them ready for the trial of the case. The case was called, the Commonwealth announced ready. What do you say Judge Bethurum for the defendant? I have just arrived, have not had time to talk with my client, nor my witnesses much, and as it is about noon, I will ask the court to adjourn for dinner, and I think we will be ready to try the case immediately afternoon. Of course out of courtesy to the court and Court adjourned to 1 o'clock. During the hour of adjournment the Judge through some medium learned that such men as Perry Hays, Henry Lasswell, and a number of good sober discreet citizens had been summoned as jurors,

and on investigation the Judge saw he had a bad case, and with such a jury as named he could see nothing but conviction awaiting his client. The court convened according to adjournment. "What has the defendant to say now, asked the court, I think we are ready replied the attorney, I will call my witnesses and see." When he got through calling his witnesses there were no jury left, a number of these men away out in the country who was not in town when this thing occurred are now cited as witnesses. Of course a man can not be a witness and a juror at the same time. This manipulation of this case, necessitated the summons of another jury, and what lawless friends the defendant had were standing around in the court room in the marshal's way ready to get on the case. I will not tell how the verdict went in this case. I do not refer to this trial

in the way of criticism, nor in the way of finding fault to Judge Bethurum's method of law practice, but merely to show the strategy that may be used to defeat justice. I look upon L. W. Bethurum as a good lawyer and as my personal friend, and if I had a case to be tried and especially in Rockcastle County, I would want him on my side. But my purpose is to show Civic League, and the organization effected at Mt. Vernon, that they will find it hard to kick against the pricks. I think it would pay the good people of this county, to have a mass meeting and make an earnest effort to enlist if possible all the attorneys of our county to join in with us in this great undertaking, and let the boot-egger and whiskey seller know that he will have to give up his business or go to some other county to get a lawyer to defend him. The county could

afford to pay our attorneys something to join in and help to convict this lawless element in our county. I have enough faith in our attorneys to believe that this thing can be effected by a proper effort on the part of the christian and sober people of this county. It is a awful thing for our people to be compelled to submit to the much drinking that is being done in our county, in the face of the law as we now have it. I think it will mean much to our county lawyers in the outcome to all join in one league, and as my friend said, make Rockcastle County a place to live happy in, where we can raise our children free from this contaminating traffic.
