

The year 1902 has an awful record to leave behind. Fully 100,000 persons have been killed this year in great disasters. Less than one-half this number were killed by the eruption of Mt. Pelee. The United States claims a large share.

The potato crop of the United States this season is the second largest ever raised. It is officially setimated by the Department of Agriculture at 283,000,000 bushels on 2,965,587 acres, the yield being 95.4 bushels per acre, against 65.5 bushels last year. The largest crop ever raised was 297,237,370 bushels in 1895.

According to the postmaster general's report, the rural free delivery service is being developed so rapidly that it is expected to cover the rural district of the entire country within the next three years. When the achievement is realized the total area covered by the daily free delivery system will be about a million square miles. This complete service will require about 40,000 carriers, and its gross annual cost not counting the compensating revenue will be about \$24,000,000.

The quickest way to warm a room in the morning is to open the doors and windows a few moments, long enough to change the air. The philosophy of this is that the air of a room or house, after being closed over night, is impure and sluggish, somewhat like muddy water, says an exchange. Fresh air is pure, buoyant and active, and will circulate quickly through the rooms, carrying the warmth of stoves or radiators swiftly to every corner. Besides that, there is joy and comfort in breathing fresh air. Try it once.

Renewed attention is being drawn to the fact that hardly any of the leading men of New York were born in that city. This is especially noticeable in professional and commercial life, nearly all the prominent editors, lawyers, preachers and financiers and many leading physicians hail originally from outside the confines of Manhattan Island. No native New Yorker was ever elected President. There have been, since 1777, when George Clinton was elected Governor, 55 gubernatorial elections, but only four of the long list were born New Yorkers. In the past 50 years but one New York city man has been elected to the United States Senate.
