In old English publications the word was spelled Ambergrease. Ambergris is French, and means gray amber, gris means gray. It is a substance of the consistence of wax, and is found floating on the waters of the Indian ocean and other tropical waters.

During the seventeenth century it appears a species of this whale was stranded on the coast of Norfolk, England, which was particularly commemorated by Sir Thomas Brown, who seemed to have been willing to have discovered ambergrease in it, but was impelled by the intolerable factor of the animal, which had lain for several days in a state of putrefaction.


