President Assassinated!

In the Pan-American Exposition at Buffalo, New York, Yesterday Afternoon.

Buffalo, N. Y., Sept. 6—

President William McKinley was shot twice by an assassin, once in the chest and once in the abdomen, while in the Music Hall of the Pan-American Exposition, in this city, this afternoon, and is now lying in a critical condition in the hospital upon the Exposition grounds. His wounds are considered fatal.

An Anarchist by the name of Fred. Neiman, a Pole, approached the President as if to shake hands, having a pistol concealed in his hand, under a handkerchief, and when the President put out his hand shot him twice. Mr. McKinley calmly bowed to a detective and walked to a chair.

The latest bulletins state that the President will live.
