**Aluminum Clock Hands.**  
"One of the finest and lightest materials that are now largely used for making clock hands is aluminum," said a leading clock manufacturer recently. "Until recently the pointers of big clocks, when not made of wood, were composed of two thin strips of copper, which were capped or hollowed and then brought together, edge to edge, with the rounded sides out, thus giving strength as well as lightness. The aluminum clock pointers are made just in the same way as the copper ones, but they possess the merit of being twice as light and are far easier to balance."

"It isn't unusual on large clocks to see projecting from the base of the long pointer and in line with it a rod with a ball at the end, this rod being perhaps a third as long as the big pointer. This rod and ball act as a counterweight for the big pointer, which, without a counterweight, would in its movement around the dial bear unevenly upon the arbor or shaft which carries it. On great clocks and often on big timepieces indoors this counterweight is placed inside the dial out of sight on the arbor."

"The heavier the pointer the greater the weight required in the counterweight; the greater the weight the more friction on the arbor, and the more friction the greater the power required to drive the clock. By the use of aluminum pointers these drawbacks are reduced to a minimum."—Washington Star.
