Drift of Republican Thought.

Denouncing the imperialistic policy of the President, William Morton Grinnell, a prominent Indiana Republican, an appointee of Benjamin Harrison and a nephew of Levi P. Morton recently declared that he would vote for Judge Parker. His announcement is another sign of the drift of Republican thought toward constitutionalism as opposed to imperialism. Mr. Grinnell comes of a family which for three generations has upheld the traditions of the party which he has left. His grandfather was one of the members of the electoral college who voted for the first Harrison. Mr. Grinnell served under Benjamin Harrison as Third Assistant Secretary of State. "My decision," said Mr. Grinnell, "has been reached after much thought on this subject. The President may be all very well in his place, but I think that he would do better as a Viking in the Ninth Century than as the ruler of this country. His acts have gone beyond the bounds of law and in many cases he has fomented class and race hatred by his politics. Perhaps there is no objection to a President being a little autocratic, but he has oversteered the Constitution and disregarded the law. His making of appointments during a constructive recess, that is, in reality no recess, is a case in point. His conduct with regard to the Panama canal is ridiculous. It is more absurd than illegal for an eminent domain applied to a foreign State."
