

#### Boy Horribly Mangled in L. & N. Yards.

Prince Hornsby, a lad about 15 years of age, was found by the crew of a switch engine near the coal chute in the Paris yards of the Louisville & Nashville Railroad at 4:20 a. m. Tuesday morning, the engine stopping a few feet from the body. When found both the boy's legs and one arm were horribly mangled, and a deep gash in his head. He was removed to the office of Yardmaster George W. Wilder and medical aid summoned, Drs. Fithian & Daugherty responding. He told his name and said he lived at Winchester with his mother and had run off in search of work.

A special train was made up and with a clear track, made a quick run to Lexington in the hope of saving the boy's life. The lad was taken by Dr. Daugherty to St. Joseph's Hospital. It is supposed that Hornsby made an attempt to board fast freight No. 85, South bound, and fell under the moving train. He died soon after reaching the hospital.

#### A Deal On For Hospital Property.

A deal is now on whereby it is proposed to buy the residence and four acres of ground from Mrs. Frank Fithian for the Paris Hospital. The place is the old home place of the late G. G. White, and one that would make an ideal hospital.

The building is a two-story pressed brick structure with wide halls, dining room, reception rooms, and with verandas twelve feet wide and three hundred feet long. It contains twenty large rooms, each of which is provided with large closets. There is sixty-one acres of land. It is proposed to sell the residence, which originally cost Mr. White \$45,000, and four acres of ground to the Hospital League for \$17,000.

If this deal goes through, George B. Mosely & Co., real estate dealers, will make a plat of the remaining fifty-seven acres into the building lots, with wide streets and alleys.

It is proposed to ask the city to join the promoters and construct a bridge from Main street, at the jail across Houston creek, including a foot bridge for pedestrians. If the deal is consummated it will mark a new era in the progress of the city by opening up a section having no objectionable features as a residence district.
