Sagaser on the night of September 25, on Pleasant street, in this city. The defendant is represented by Attorney J. J. Williams and Hon. E. M. Dickson, while the Commonwealth is represented by Commonwealth's Attorney, R. B. Franklin and County Attorney T. E. Moore, Jr. The case was called Friday and has since occupied the time of the court. 
