Episcopal Congregation of Paris Passes Resolutions.

At the morning service at St. Peter's Church, Paris, Ky., the Rector called attention to the fact that it had come to his ears that the Rev. Carey E. Morgan, pastor of the Christian Church of this city, had tendered his resignation and was about to depart to another field, and suggested that, in view of the high esteem in which Brother Morgan is held by our people, it might be well to tender him some formal expression of our esteem for him and our best wishes for success in his new field of labor.

At a meeting held immediately after service, it was unanimously resolved, that a committee be appointed to draft suitable resolutions.

The committee has suggested the following:

Whereas, we have learned that Brother Morgan, pastor of the Christian Church of this city, has tendered his resignation from that work and is about to remove to another field of labor in another section of the country, and,

Whereas, Brother Morgan has endeared himself to the people of St. Peter's Parish, because of his splendid manly character, broad, tolerant, Christian spirit and kindly neighborly ministrations, therefore, be it

Resolved, That, we the Rector, Church Wardens, Vestry and Congregation of St. Peter's Parish learn with deepest regret that the pleasant associations of so many years are about to be broken by the removal of Brother Morgan to another field, and be it further

Resolved, That we extend to Brother Morgan our best wishes for the success of his future work, and assure him of our sincere prayers for God's blessing upon him and his, in his new field of endeavor.

It was further directed that a copy of the above expression be sent Brother Morgan and that the same be published.
