MUSIC MEMORY CONTEST BY P. H. S. PUPILS

An event that is exciting a great deal of interest in schools circles is a "Music Memory Contest," which is to be staged by pupils of the Paris High School at an early date. The material to be used in the contest will be selected by a committee chosen from citizens of Paris, who will also have the publicity and prize features of the contest in charge.

These contests are conducted annually in a number of cities, the object being to familiarize every child with a number of standard musical compositions, their forms and instrumentations, biographical knowledge of composers, and to increase the interest in music in the entire community.
