**Fish That Cannot Swim.** More than one species of fish is met with which cannot swim, the most singular of which perhaps is the mullus, a Brazilian fish, whose organs of locomotion enable it to crawl or walk or hop, after the manner of a toad, to which animal this fish is some extent bears a resemblance, and it is provided with a peculiarly shaped fin. The anterior (pectoral) fins of the mullus, which are quite small, are not capable of acting on the water, but can only move backward and forward. The posterior (caudal) fins are also of a peculiar shape, and are very different from the similar fins of other fishes and could not serve for swimming at all.

Other names of nonswimming fishes include the sea horse, another most peculiarly shaped inhabitant of the sea, which resembles the knight in a set of chessmen, and the starfish.
