There is nothing unusual, improper or illegal in the matter."

And he receives by his own confession, \$325 more than the law gives him, and says he does not know where it all comes from, and yet and yet! he says that he does know that no public service corporation contributes, and that neither have any of the contributors been the objects of special favors from the

The class of people aimed at in the Bill is the hard working class. Few Mayors are found amongst them, and hardly a one ever runs for Congress, or is paid not to run. The Bill has not yet become a law, but before it does it should also prohibit Mayors and other officials from receiving "donations," gratuities or "tips." It would be a good bill with that amendment.
